<p>OBJECTIVE</p> <p>To ensure that IAOS facilities are maintained in good condition for the use and enjoyment of all community members.</p>			
<p>Policy Statement</p> <p>As the Masjid is the house of ALLAH SWT, we are under a duty to treat it with the utmost of respect. This policy sets out the acceptable uses of the Masjid and the rules that all visitors must follow when using the Masjid to protect against damage or misuse.</p>			
<p>Policy:</p> <p style="margin-left: 20px;"><u>General Guidelines</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children must be supervised by their parents or a responsible adult at all times • The parents of children who cause damage to the Masjid will be responsible for the cost of repairing the damage • Signs or posters of any kind may not be hung or displayed in the Masjid except with the prior approval of the Board • Brothers may not use the Sister’s Prayer Hall without the Board’s permission • Eating is not permitted anywhere in the Masjid except in the Kitchen Basement Area and in the Main Lobby • Visitors are expected to leave the Masjid in the same or better condition than when they arrived <p style="margin-left: 20px;"><u>Facility Reservations</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unless it pertains to regularly scheduled programs or services, visitors wishing to use the Masjid for a special purpose, gathering, or meeting must get the prior approval of the Board. • The Masjid will be locked one hour after Isha salat an reopened again for Fajr salat. Those seeking to use the Masjid during lock-up hours must get the prior approval of the Board.
